




Pupil Premium - School Uniform Vouchers

We would like to make parents aware of a uniform voucher service that is available to all parents of children who are in receipt of free school meals or eligible for Pupil Premium funding. We are now using a portion of our Pupil Premium funding to offer parents a uniform voucher per pupil. These vouchers can be used to purchase any two items of school uniform (or equivalent) at Keywear in Truro. If you are in receipt of income support, income based job seeker's allowance, income related employment support and allowance, child tax credits (with an annual income of no more than £16,190) then your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. If you

think your child may be eligible for Pupil Premium funding / free school meals, please call the school office to fill out a short form or look on our school website. Pupil Premium funding is available to children in all year groups and is in addition to the Universal Infant Free School meals which is available to all KS1 pupils. Every child who is registered as eligible for pupil premium generates valuable income for the school and this eligibility will also help you access financial assistance with various school costs such as trips, clubs and music tuition.





If your child is ill or cannot attend school for whatever reason, parents must telephone the School Office (01872 572021) to inform us of the details - don't Dojo the class teacher. Messages can be left on the school answerphone service. It is important that parents always let the School Office know if their child cannot attend school. If we do not receive a notification of absence, it is our safeguard-



ing duty contact parents to find out the reasons for this.

If your child requires a planned absence from school for medical appointments, dental appointments etc, please collect an Absence Application Form from the School Office. The school cannot authorise absences for the purpose of holiday or other avoidable absences during term time. Absences not authorised by the school may result in issuing a Penalty Notice or prosecution in the Magistrates Court. Thank you for your understanding.

Family groups will spend time with a different teacher each week and take part in a different activity that is focused around creative, experiential, calm, collaborative and fun learning tasks. We will encourage our older pupils to support and nurture younger pupils and for tasks to be interactive so that children are engaging with one another and working collaboratively in different ways and enjoying a different type of learning.
