As many parents will already know and appreciate, the Department for Education has tasked schools with improving school attendance and monitoring absences closely after the impact of the pandemic. To this end, we have are now working with a very rigorous attendance policy from our Academy Trust and closely monitor broken weeks, illnesses and any other absences.

Since this new approach has been adopted, we have become aware of some occasional absences where pupils have been telephoned in as 'sick', but children have then talked of different reasons for their absence upon their return - a holiday for example or even a birthday.
