She kindly invited Jan Woodhouse (TPAT Secondary Lead) and I (Mr Johnson) to attend as well. Although Mr Moon wasn't able to give us any definitive answers about the plans going ahead or not, it was a very useful meeting for us to be able to champion the need for this school and the passion for it within our community. We were able to explain to Mr Moon the challenges faced by our children in terms of their access to secondary education and the underserving of Perranporth in this regard.

By the time we concluded the meeting, I can fully assure parents, that Mr Moon is now very much in the picture with regards to how disappointed you all feel and how necessary it is for these plans to go ahead. He explained that he would be escalating the matter and the very strong feelings of our community, as well doing his best to ensure that our voice is heard in the review.
